

"El Moshaah" Names of God Series December 9, 2018

"And those who know your name put their trust in you."

Psalm 9:10

• El Moshaah is the God Who <u>SAVES</u>. Luke 2:22-35

El Moshaah means:

1. God <u>RESCUES</u> us. Psalm 9:9, Isaiah 58:4

Two ways God rescues us:

- a. He REMOVES us from our troubles. Psalm 40:1-2
- b. He <u>SUSTAINS</u> us through our troubles. James 1:2-4, Psalm 46:1, Psalm 94:18
- 2. God DELIVERS us.

2 Kings 17:39, 1 Chronicles 21:2, Matthew 5:44

God's deliverance comes in a couple manners:

- a. God <u>LIBERATES</u> us from our enemy. Isaiah 61:1, Luke 4:18-19, 4:31-35, Luke 13:16, Romans 16:20, 1 John 3:8
- b. God <u>PROTECTS</u> us along the way. Ezra 8:31, 1 Peter 5:8, Psalm 91
- 3. God SAVES us.

Matthew 1:21

- a. He <u>FORGIVES</u> our sins. 2 Corinthians 5:21, Ephesians 2:8-9
- b. He gives us <u>VICTORY</u> over our sins. 1 Corinthians 15:57, Genesis 4:7, Romans 7:19-20, 8:13

Ouestions to Consider:

- Do I need God to rescue me this morning? Do I need Him to sustain me?
- Do I need God to deliver me today? Where do I need liberation? Where do I need protection?
- Do I need salvation this morning? Have I put my faith in Christ? Do I need victory over sin?
