

"Forgiveness" January 20, 2019

"Just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you are also to forgive." Colossians 3:13

Definition of <u>Forgive</u>: to <u>SEND</u> away, to <u>LET</u> go, give up a debt, to <u>LEAVE</u>, go way from one in order to go to another place.

Some lessons on forgiveness:

- 1. Forgiveness is foundational to the <u>MESSAGE</u> of Christ. Matthew 26:28
 - a. Jesus <u>PREACHED</u> forgiveness. Lk 6:37, Matt 6:15, Mark 11:25
 - b. Jesus <u>GAVE</u> forgiveness. Mark 2:5, Luke 5:12, Luke 7:47-48
 - c. Jesus <u>DISPLAYED</u> forgiveness. Luke 23:34
- 2. Forgiveness is essential to our <u>LIFE</u> in Christ. Matthew 23:24
 - a. Forgiveness is <u>EXPECTED</u> of us. Mark 11:25, Matthew 6:12
 - b. Forgiveness is <u>COMMANDED</u> of us. Luke 17:4, Matthew 18:21-22
 - c. Forgiveness <u>UNIFIES</u> us. Colossians 3:12-14
- 3. Forgiveness displays the <u>GLORY</u> of Christ. Acts 7:54-60, Colossians 3:13
 - Our forgiveness <u>TESTIFIES</u> that Christ is in us. Galatians 2:20, Matthew18:23-35,
