Luke 23:23-38

When we find ourselves "hanging on the cross" or going through the "valley of the shadow of death" or in the "lions' den" or in the "furnace of affliction" ...or whatever hard and painful moment that is, we need to:

- 1. <u>FOCUS</u> Exclusively Luke 6:45, Isaiah 53:3
 - Exclusive focus means <u>FAITHFUL</u> ministry. Galatians 5:22, Matthew 23:23
- 2. <u>LOVE</u> Unconditionally Matthew 5:44, 46, Galatians 5:22
- 3. PRAY Comprehensively Matthew 5:44, Luke 5:31
 - The Father <u>VALUES</u> everyone! 2 Peter 3:9, Acts 16:25-34
- 4. SUBMIT Entirely Luke 9:23, Acts 20:23

Questions to Consider

- Where is my focus right now? Am I exclusively focused on the Father or am I focused on my excruciating circumstances?
- Do I have an unconditional love for those in my life?
- Do I pray comprehensively for those in my life and specifically for those who are against me?
- Am I submitted entirely to the purposes of God even if I know hardships await me?
