## John 19:23-27

- 1. We are <u>ADOPTED</u> into the family of God. Romans 8:15
  - a. God is our <u>FATHER</u>. Matthew 6:9, 2 Corinthians 6:16-18
  - b. We are His <u>CHILDREN</u>. 2 Corinthians 6:17-18
    - i. We are all <u>SAINTS</u>.Ephesians 1:1
    - ii. We have direct <u>ACCESS</u> to the Father. Ephesians 2:18, Mark 10:14
  - iii. We are His <u>WORKMANSHIP</u>. Ephesians 2:10, Romans 1:20
- 2. We are <u>COHEIRS</u> with Christ. Romans 8:17, Galatians 2:20
  - a. We receive an <u>INHERITANCE</u> in Christ. 1 Peter 1:4, James 2:5, Ephesians 5:5, Galatians 5:21, 1 Corinthians 6:10
  - b. We will <u>REIGN</u> with Christ.2 Timothy 2:11-12, Genesis 1:26, Revelation 20:6

- 3. We <u>CARE</u> for each other in the family of God. 1 Timothy 5:8
  - We care for our faith family by meeting both practical and spiritual NEEDS.
    1 Corinthians 12:25, 1 Peter 4:9, James 2:16, 5:16, Galatians 6:1
