## John 19:28-29

- 1. Christ's Humanity

- a. Jesus claimed to be <u>ONE</u> with God. John 10:30-31
- b. Jesus had the authority to <u>FORGIVE</u> sins. Mark 2:5-7, Matthew 26:65-66
- Jesus displayed divine <u>ATTRIBUTES</u>.
  Mark 4:39-41, Psalm 89:8-9, Mark 2:8, John 6:64, Matthew 2:11, 14:33, 28:17
- 3. The Necessity of His Humanity

Jesus had to be a man in order to:

- a. Be our sacrificial <u>SUBSTITUTE</u>. Hebrews 2:17
- b. Be our MEDIATOR. 1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 9:15
- c. Be our EXAMPLE. 1 John 2:6
