"I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning..." Luke 1:3

- 1. The <u>PERSON</u> of Luke
 - a. Luke was a <u>GENTILE</u>. Colossians 4:10-14, Galatians 3:28
 - b. Luke was a <u>DOCTOR</u>. Colossian 4:14, Luke 22:44
 - c. Luke was an <u>HISTORIAN</u>. Luke 2:1-2
 - d. Luke was a <u>THEOLOGIAN</u>.
 - i. Luke 1-6, 10-18: Jesus is the Great <u>PROPHET</u>.
 - ii. Luke 7-9: Jesus is the Great <u>PRIEST</u>.
 - iii. Luke 19-24: Jesus is the Great <u>KING</u>.
 - e. Luke was a <u>MISSIONARY</u>. Colossians 4:14, 2 Timothy 4:11 and Philemon 1:24, Acts 16:10
- 2. The <u>GOSPEL</u> of Luke.

Three of Luke's major themes:

- a. Luke's Gospel is <u>UNIVERSAL</u>. Luke 2:32, Isaiah 40:3-5, Luke 3:23-37, 16:19-31, 8:1-3, 21:1-4, 10:38-42, 23:55-24:11
- b. Luke's Gospel emphasizes <u>PRAYER</u>. Luke 3:21, 5:16, 6:12, 11:5-13, 18:1-8, 22:31-32
- c. Luke's Gospel asserts the role of the <u>HOLY</u> <u>SPIRIT</u>. Luke 1:15, 4:1, 14, 24:49

Question to Consider:

- Have I submitted my life in such a way as to be used as Luke was?
- Do I live a Gospel driven-prayer centered-Holy Spirit dependent life?

What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?
