- 1. Mary trusted God without <u>UNDERSTANDING</u> His plan. Luke 1:18, 20, 45
 - a. Trusting God means we <u>BELIEVE</u> His Word. Hebrews 11:1, Proverbs 3:5, Genesis 16
 - b. Trusting God means we <u>SUBMIT</u> to His Word. Luke 1:38

Luke 1:46-56

- 2. Mary trusted God through <u>PRAISING</u> Him for His plan. Job 1:21
 - a. Trusting God means we praise Him before His plan is even <u>FINISHED</u>. Psalm 34:1, Matthew 12:34
 - b. Trusting God means we praise Him for <u>WHO HE IS</u>. Revelation 5:12,

Question to Consider:

- Do I trust Him even when I don't understand what He is doing?
- Do I believe His Word? Am I submitting to His Word?
- Am I willing to praise for who He is?
- Am I willing to praise Him even before His Word is fulfilled?
- Is His praise ever on my lips?
