

"Preparing to Implement God's Plan" A Look at Luke Luke 1:57-80 July 14, 2019

Luke 1:57-66

How to prepare for God's plan:

- 1. We must know <u>WHO</u> God has called us to be. Leviticus 12:1-3, Luke 1:13
 - a. Don't <u>LISTEN</u> to the world: they will label you as they see fit. Genesis 25:25-26, 32:22-32
 - b. Believe that God has called us to be children of <u>GRACE</u>. John 1:14, Ephesians 2:8-9, 1 Corinthians 15:10

Luke 1:67-80

- 2. We must know <u>WHAT</u> God has called us to do. Psalm 65:8, Matthew 28:18-20
 - a. Prioritize His UNIVERSAL plan for us. (vs 68-75)
 - i. God desires to <u>REDEEM</u> us. (vs 68-70)
 - ii. God desires to <u>RESCUE</u> us. (vs 71-74a) Colossians 1:13, Romans 6:6
 - iii. God desires to <u>RESTORE</u> us. (vs 74b-75) Romans 3:22, 1 Peter 1:15
 - b. Synchronize His <u>PERSONAL</u> plan for us. (vs 76-79) Acts 9:15, 1 Corinthians 3:5

Question to Consider:

- Do I know who God has called me to be?
- Do I live as a child of grace or am I listening to who the world says I am?
- Do I get what God has called me to do?
- Do I know what His personal plan is for my life?
- Is His personal plan for my life synchronized with His universal plan?

What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?
