

"Kingdom Authority" A Look at Luke Luke 4:31-44 November 3, 2019

"They were amazed at his teaching, because His words had authority." Luke 4:32

**Our Kingdom Authority enables us to:** 

- 1. Teach with <u>AUTHORITY</u> (31-32)
  - a. Authoritative teaching is <u>ANOINTED</u>. Isaiah 61:1, Mark 1:22, John 7:46
  - b. Authoritative teaching demonstrates His <u>POWER</u>. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5, 2 Corinthians 1:21-22
- 2. Confront <u>EVIL</u> (33-37, 41) Mark 1:39, Luke 13:6
  - a. The presence of evil is <u>REAL</u>. Ephesians 6:12
  - b. Evil has been and will be <u>DEFEATED</u>. Colossians 2:15, Matthew 8:29, Revelation 20:10
- 3. Show <u>COMPASSION</u> (38-40) Matthew 9:36, 14:14, 20:34
  - a. To show compassion is to <u>REFLECT</u> the heart of the Father. 2 Corinthians 1:3, Psalm 116:5
  - b. Compassion often means a <u>PERSONAL</u> touch. Ephesians 4:32
  - c. Compassionate ministry can be <u>EXHAUSTING</u>. Luke 5:16
