A few thoughts concerning the nature of God's Promises:

- I. God is <u>FAITHFUL</u> to all His promises. Psalm 145:13
- II. Some of God's promises are <u>CONDITIONAL</u>. Deuteronomy 28:1-14
- III. Some of God's promises are <u>UNCONDITIONAL</u>. Genesis 9:11, Psalm 145:13, 136:2

Standing on God's Promises through Adversity:

- 1. God promises to be our <u>REFUGE</u>. Psalm 91:1-4, Luke 13:34, Matthew 11:28
- 2. God promises to give us <u>STRENGTH</u>. Psalm 29:11, Isaiah 40:29, 31
- 3. God promises to <u>GO</u> with us. Isaiah in 43:2-3, Psalm 46:1, Romans 12:15
