The establishment of the New Covenant brings to us:

- NEW Life (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- ABUNDANT Life (John 10:10)
- ETERNAL Life (John 3:16)

Why we do not have to follow the Law under the New Covenant:

<b>1.</b>	Jeremiah 31:31-32b, Luke 22:20, Hebrews 8:6-8, 13
2.	The Law was <u>FULFILLED</u> through Christ. Matthew 5:17, Romans 10:4, John 19:30, Romans 3:22
3.	The Law was the <u>FORESHADOW</u> of Christ. 1 Corinthians 10:4, Colossians 2:16-17, Galatians 5:1
