Trivia: Who was known as the weeping prophet?
Did you know? Early references to the Hebrew Bible (Old Testament) mention only 22 or 24 books in it, instead of 39, as found in Christian Bibles, even though their contents are identical. This is because books such as 1 and 2 Kings are counted as one, and the 12 minor prophets were counted as one, call the Book of the Twelve.
