

"Discipleship Development" A Look at Luke Luke 6:12-16 March 8, 2020

"He appointed twelve that they might be with him and that he might send them out to preach..." Mark 3:14

Context: (2 Cor 5:20, Acts 12:2, Acts 1:26)

How we grow and develop as His Disciples:

- 1. Draw near to the <u>TEACHER</u>. Mark 3:14
 - a. Drawing near means to <u>KNOW</u> Him. Phil 3:10, Matt 7:22-23
 - b. Drawing near means to <u>HEAR</u> Him. Matt 11:15, Rev 2:7, John 10:27
 - c. Drawing near means to <u>SEE</u> Him. Psalm 27:4, Eph 1:18
- 2. Submit to His <u>TRAINING</u>. John 21:25
 - a. Pray for spiritual <u>UNDERSTANDING</u>. Matthew 16:9, Mark 8:17, Matthew 16:11, Mark 4:13, 33
 - b. Pray for increased <u>FAITH</u>. Matt 8:26, 14:31, Luke 12:28, Matt 8:10, Mark 6:6, Luke 17:5
 - c. Pray for His <u>POWER</u>. Luke 9:1-2, Acts 1:4, 8

- 3. Engage the <u>TASK</u> He's assigned to us.
 - a. Answer the <u>GENERAL</u> call to make disciples. Matt 28:18-20
 - b. Answer His <u>SPECIFIC</u> call to your ministry. 1 Cor 3:5

Question to Consider:

- What am I doing to draw near to Jesus?
- What aspect of training do I need to pray through the most? Understanding? Faith? Power? Something else?
- Can I identify the ministry He has called me to? Have I engaged this task with all my heart?

What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?
