How we grow and develop as His Disciples:

1. Draw near to the TEACHER.

Mark 3:14

- a. Drawing near means to KNOW Him. Phil 3:10, Matt 7:22-23
- b. Drawing near means to HEAR Him. Matt 11:15, Rev 2:7, John 10:27
- c. Drawing near means to SEE Him. Psalm 27:4, Eph 1:18

2. Submit to His TRAINING.

John 21:25

- a. Pray for spiritual UNDERSTANDING. Matthew 16:9, Mark 8:17, Matthew 16:11, Mark 4:13, 33
- b. Pray for increased FAITH. Matt 8:26, 14:31, Luke 12:28, Matt 8:10, Mark 6:6, Luke 17:5
- c. Pray for His POWER. Luke 9:1-2, Acts 1:4, 8

3. Engage the TASK He's assigned to us.

a. Answer the GENERAL call to make disciples. Matt 28:18-20

b. Answer His SPECIFIC call to your ministry. 1 Cor 3:5

Question to Consider:

- What am I doing to draw near to Jesus?
- What aspect of training do I need to pray through the most? Understanding? Faith? Power? Something else?
- Can I identify the ministry He has called me to? Have I engaged this task with all my heart?

What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?
