2to Christ. (vs 47a) James 4:8	 Questions to Consider: Am I merely a professing Christian, or do I possess a personal relationship with Him? What I am I doing in my life to come to, or draw near to Christ? What evidence do I display in my life that I hear, perceive and understand Christ? Can my life be described as an Incarnational-Gospel? Why or why not?
