

"Return Ready: An Enduring Hope" August 30, 2020

"If I go away... I will come again and take you to myself, so that where I am you may be also." John 14:3

The Affirmation of Scripture concerning the End-Times:

- 1. Scripture affirms the <u>RETURN</u> of our King. Zechariah 14:3-4, Matthew 24:30, John 14:3, John 14:3, Acts 1:11, Revelation 1:7
  - Scholars have counted <u>1,845</u> biblical references to Jesus' second coming.
  - Christ's return in emphasized in no less than <u>17</u> Old Testament books and in <u>7</u> out of every 10 chapters in the New Testament.
  - Jesus referred to His return 21 times.
  - The second coming is <u>SECOND</u> only to faith as the most dominant subject in the New Testament.
- 2. Scripture affirms the <u>RAPTURE</u> of the Church. 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17
  - a. The rapture is a <u>SURPRISE</u> event. Matthew 24:36, 1 Thessalonians 5:1-2
  - b. The rapture is a <u>SUDDEN</u> event. 1 Corinthians 15:52
  - c. The rapture is a <u>SELECTIVE</u> event.
    1 Corinthians 15:23, Revelation 21:27, 1 Thessalonians 4:14

- 3. Scripture affirms the eternal <u>REIGN</u> of Christ. Revelation 19:16, Isaiah 9:7
  - a. Christ is victorious over the <u>DEVIL</u>. Revelation 20:10
  - b. Christ is victorious over <u>DISEASE</u>. Genesis 3:17, Galatians 3:13, Revelation 22:2-3
  - c. Christ is victorious over <u>DEATH</u>.
    1 Corinthians 15:54-55, Revelation 21:4-5

- Am I living with hope? If not, why not?
- Am I ready for the return of the King? Have I repented of my sins, submitted to Him as Lord and embraced my new identity as His child?
