Esther 8:11, 9:16

1.	God <u>APPOINTED</u> protective measures for the innocent. Numbers 35:9-34, Proverbs 6:17, 1 Samuel 19:10, Acts 9:25, John 8:59
2.	God <u>ALLOWED</u> a show of force to protect His people and deter the enemy. Nehemiah 1:4, 2:12, 4:17-18
3.	God <u>ARRANGED</u> for defensive and protective measures
	through civil law.

4. Iesus ADVISED taking precautionary defense measures.
