

"Outside the Basket" A Look at Luke Luke 9:12-17 January 10, 2021

"Now to him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us." Ephesians 3:20

When we look from within the basket:

1. We tend to focus on the <u>DESOLATE</u> circumstances. Genesis 17:17, 18:12, 39:17, 2 Corinthians 5:7

2. We tend to <u>DETAIL</u> our inadequacies. Mark 6:37, Exodus 4:10, Jeremiah 1:7, Judges 6:15, Jonah 4:1-2, Luke 1:18, 1 Corinthians 1:28

When we look outside the basket:

3. We take our <u>DIRECTIVES</u> from Christ. Psalm 123:1-2, Matthew 14:29, John 9:6-7, 5:8, Matthew 5:44, 18:21-22 4. We avail ourselves for God to <u>DO</u> a work through us. Malachi 3:10, 1 Corinthians 12:12, Luke 1:38

5. We get to see God's <u>DIVINE</u> nature shine! Ephesians 3:20, Genesis 17:1-3

Questions to Consider:

- Do I tend to look from within the basket and focus on my desolate circumstances or on my inadequacies?
- Do I lift my eyes to the throne of God and take my directives from Him? Or will I tend to listen to others first or maybe my fears and discomfort or my doubts?
- Do I make myself available for God to do His work through my life? Do I live as "distributor" of God's grace in its various forms?
- Do know God as the All-Sufficient One who is able to provide for everything? Do live in His Divine-Shine as the God who is able to do above and beyond I could ever imagine?
