**Commitment to Christ means:** 

1. We are willing to live with <u>HARDSHIPS</u>. (vs 57-58) Acts 5:41, 2 Corinthians 11:24-28

2. We are ready to embrace the <u>URGENT</u>. (vs 59-60) Exodus 20:12, Matthew 4:18-22, Revelation 12:12 **Question to Consider:** 

- How would I describe my commitment to Christ?
- How would Jesus describe my commitment to Him?
- Am I willing to endure hardships for the sake of Christ?
- Do I serve Jesus with a sense of urgency?
- Am I focused on Jesus or am I distracted by "looking back?"

What is the Holy Spirit prompting me to do?

3. We are eager to keep the <u>FOCUS</u>. (vs 61-62) Genesis 19:26, 2 Kings 19:19-21, Hebrews 12:1-2
