	We steward our <u>RESPONSIBILITIES</u> given by God. Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:19, 2 Corinthians 10:13, Acts 22:10
3.	We steward our <u>RELATIONSHIP</u> with God. Deuteronomy 24:1, Matthew 19:8, James 4:8

Questions to Consider:

- How well do I steward my riches/wealth/resources from God? Do I live as though it all belongs to Him and is it completely available for the sake of building His Kingdom?
- Do I steward my responsibility well? Do I know my Kingdom assignment or area of ministry and am I serving diligently?
- What is the evidence that I steward my relationship with God for His glory and not my own? What fruit can be seen in my life affirming that God is above all?
