To Endure Well to the End We Must:

1. Be PRUDENT

Mark 13:32-37, 1 Peter 4:7

2. Be PERCEPTIVE

Dan 5:5-6, 25-28, Luke 12:54-56, Matt 16:2-3, Ps 32:9, 1Jn 2:27

3. Be PRAYERFUL

Ps 109:4, Dan 10:12, Jer 33:3, Ps 122:6-7, Isa 9:6

4. Be PATIENT

Romans 8:23, 2 Timothy 3:1-5, Hebrews 12:2, Luke 21:28

5. Be PRODUCTIVE

Matthew 28:18-20, 24:14

“But when these things begin to take place, stand up and lift your heads, because your redemption is near.” Luke 21:28

Question to Consider:

- Do I live with spiritual prudence (watchfulness or alertness)?
- Do I seek biblical perception concerning the events of our time?
