Evidence of a Coming Kingdom Focus:

Matthew 2:1, Acts 1:3, 6, 28:23, John 6:15

The Kingdom of God Demands:

1. ENDURANCE until it comes.

2 Samuel 7:11-16, Psalm 24:8-9, Isaiah 11:3-9, 65:17-25,

2 Timothy 2:12, Hebrews 10:36, 12:1, 2 Peter 3:3-4

2. ENGAGEMENT until it comes.

John 20:22, Acts 1:8, 2:38, Galatians 3:2, Luke 24:49

• What kind of heart do we need to invest *with* the Holy Spirit?

**a. A heart that BELIEVES there is potential for a return.
Matthew 14:22-31, Acts 17:6**

**b. A heart with DESIRE to just do it.
Mark 6:7-13**

**c. A heart that is WILLING to risk.
2 Corinthians 11:23-28**

**d. A heart that thinks ETERNALLY.
2 Timothy 4:8, 1 Peter 5:4, James 1:12**

Questions to Consider:

- How is my spiritual endurance as we anticipate the coming Kingdom? Has weariness or impatience snuck in?**
- Is my “Kingdom Engagement” merely activity or is it driven by a heart for Jesus?**
