"But when these things begin to take place, <u>stand up</u> and <u>lift</u> <u>your heads</u>, because <u>your redemption is near</u>." Luke 21:28

Four Categories of Biblical Signs:

1. COSMIC Signs

Genesis 1:14, Deuteronomy 4:19, Psalm 19:1-4, Joshua 10:12-13, Isaiah 38:7-8, Matthew 2:1-2, 27:45, 24:29-30

2. <u>EARTHLY</u> Signs Romans 8:21-22, Luke 21:11, Revelation 6:6, Luke 21:11

3. <u>NATIONAL</u> Signs Mark 13:7-8, Revelation 17:12-13, Daniel 9:27, 1 Thess 5:3 4. <u>SPIRITUAL</u> Signs Mark 13:12, 1 Timothy 4:1-2, 2 Timothy 3:1-5, Mark 13:9, 13, 10, Matthew 24:14, Revelation 7:9, 14

Mark 13:28-29 "Learn this lesson from the fig tree: As soon as its branch becomes tender and sprouts leaves, you know that summer is near. ²⁹ In the same way, <u>when you see these things</u> <u>happening</u>, <u>recognize that he is near – at the door</u>."

Questions to Consider:

- Do I have a healthy and biblical balance when it comes to observing the signs of our times?
- Do I live with a biblical alertness that enables me to read and recognize the signs of His nearness?
- Or do I ignore the biblical signs and thus endanger myself of receiving Jesus' rebuke of illiteracy?
